

# LAUNCH SUMMER SKATEBOARDING CAMP

## FAMILY INFORMATION SHEET 2026

Thank you for your interest in joining us for LAUNCH Summer Skateboarding Camp! This sheet answers most questions about camp. For additional questions, email [info@launchskate.org](mailto:info@launchskate.org).

### CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

All campers are expected to:

- Follow directions from staff and volunteers
- Treat all counselors and campers with respect
- Wear a buckled helmet while skateboarding; elbow, knee, and wrist pads strongly recommended
- Communicate appropriately — no foul language, gestures, or unfriendly tones
- Avoid causing physical or emotional harm, including bullying, pushing, or fighting
- Stay with assigned groups and communicate needs (water, bathroom, snack, shade) to counselors

Behavior Enforcement: Campers will receive a warning if rules are broken. Parents/guardians will be notified. Continued misbehavior may result in dismissal at Launch's discretion.

### DROP OFF & PICK UP

#### Locations:

Full-Day: Launch Skatepark, 1007 N. College Ave, Fort Collins, CO

Half-Day Morning: Assigned outdoor skateparks (emailed prior)

#### Check-In / Arrival:

Full-Day & Half-Day: 8:45–9:00am, camp begins 9:00am

#### Pick-Up:

Half-Day: 12:00pm

Full-Day: 3:00pm

Late pick-up: Full-Day optional late pickup until 5:00pm for \$15/day

Notify staff if anyone other than a parent/guardian or emergency contact will pick up your camper.

### WHAT TO BRING

- Skateboarding Gear: Skateboard and helmet required; elbow, knee, and wrist pads strongly recommended. Limited loaner gear available.
- Clothing: Weather-appropriate, close-toed shoes required.
- Hydration & Snacks: Water bottle, at least 1 snack for Half-Day, 2 snacks + lunch for Full-Day. Soda/energy drinks not recommended.
- Hand Sanitizer & Sunscreen: Bring personal sanitizer; campers must apply sunscreen themselves.

#### Gear Tips:

Deck: 7.5–8.5 inches, popsicle shape preferred

Wheels: 52–56 mm, 95–105 durometer ideal

Pads: Snug-fitting, full coverage with plastic plates; helmets must fit snugly

### CONSENT POLICY

Counselors will assist with gear, photos/videos, or trick spotting only with camper consent. All campers must wear helmets; elbow, knee, wrist protection is strongly encouraged.

**WEATHER & MINIMUM ENROLLMENT POLICY**

Full-Day Camps: Move indoors for unsafe weather (rain, lightning, flood, extreme heat)

Half-Day Morning: Temporary shelter or notification for early pickup if canceled

Camps may be canceled or combined if minimum enrollment is not met

Pro-rated refunds or program credit provided for missed days due to weather or minimum enrollment cancellations

**ILLNESS & INJURY POLICY**

Campers/staff feeling ill must stay home until symptom-free

Injuries preventing participation: eligible for full refund or program credit

**CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY**

Cancel before May 1, 2026: 100% refund

Cancel May 1 – two weeks before camp: 75% refund

Cancel less than two weeks before camp: no refund

Camp canceled by Launch: full refund issued

Processing fees non-refundable

Behavior-related expulsions: refunds considered case-by-case by Executive Director
